

PROGRAM

08.00 - Departure from Bjørnfjell Mountain Lodge

Your journey begins with a scenic drive through the spectacular arctic landscape of Finnmark. Crossing the vast plateau of Sennalandet before following the breathtaking Porsangerfjord, your local guide will share stories about the regions history, culture and nature that surrounds you.

11.30 - Arrival in Brenna with a traditional lunch

Upon arrival you are welcomed by the local Sámi family. Enjoy a traditional lunch served in a lavvo, featuring homemade reindeer meat from their own herd. Exchange stories and get to know the family traditions, culture and daily life of the reindeer herders.

12.30 - Visit the reindeer herd

You will be given warm clothing fit for the weather and start your journey to the mountain plateau by snowmobile. Here you will meet the reindeer in their natural environment. In this moment you are not a guest - you are a “reanga” or “biiga” helping the family feed the reindeer. You will learn about the traditions of herding, seasonal migrations, ear markings and the deep connections between the people, the land and the reindeer.

15.30 - Coffee with the Sámi family

Return to Brenna for coffee and some treats. Here you will be given the opportunity to talk about your experience and ask any questions to the family. You will leave Brenna with a deeper understanding of the indigenous people of Norway.

16.30 - Return journey & Northern Lights experience

As darkness falls, the journey back to Bjørnfjell becomes an experience of its own. Travelling through the remote Arctic landscape with little to no light pollution provides an excellent opportunity to spot the Northern Lights.

20.00 - 3-course dinner menu in the restaurant

The day is concluded with a set 3-course dinner at the Bjørnfjell restaurant, built upon ingredients from the places you have travelled past in this experience.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

INCLUDED IN THE EXPERIENCE:

- Transfers with guide from the lodge to the experience in Brenna
- Warm snowsuit, boots, wind proof mittens and helmet
- Traditional lunch in lavvo
- Coffee and snacks

WHAT TO PACK & WEAR:

Temperatures in the mountains can drop below minus 20 degrees celsius. Think several warm layers and wear wool closest to your body.

We recommend packing:

- Wool underwear (long-sleeves and tights)
- Thin and thick wool socks
- Middle layer - wool or fleece sweater/jacket and pants
- Alternative is a thin down jacket
- Thick and warm hat, gloves and neck-warmer/scarf
